











The 2004-2005 academic year marked the 125th year anniversary for the Corps of Cadets. This historic year was filled with many memorable events and activities. One of the most exciting events was the addition of women's basketball to our athletic programs. Coached by Captain Pam Grohs, and Major Todd Kitchen, the Lady Dragons' inaugural season was full of excitement and challenges. Starting a new program and being expected to compete against wellestablished programs was no easy feat. The Wentworth women were up to the challenge, and were successful in winning nine games, including a consolation plaque from the Central River Conference Tournament, and a fourth place plaque from the South Harrison Invitational. The team was later honored by the Missouri State High School Athletic Association for superior academic performance for obtaining a combined grade point average of 3.0 during the season. 
