

Our Thoughts on the Wentworth Football Team 2007

My words are going to sound familiar and probably somewhat cliche, based on the feedback I have been reading regarding the football team this year and the coaches we are lucky to have at Wentworth. No matter how cliche or repeated, I feel they are worth saying. Each week of the football season it was difficult to explain to people the sense of victory we felt after watching the team play. Only one week did we outscore our opponents, but every week we saw victories in our team.

This all starts with Coach Levy. Only when friends and family came to watch were they able to see what we had been telling them about. They, like us, would come to the game expecting to see your typical football game. What they couldn't explain as the game ended, was how a team that normailly looked overmatched and outnumbered played so hard. "They never quit". I wonder how many times those words are spoken at a Wentworth game. In the middle of it all is this iron of man.

...Our first trip to Wentworth...We were touring c ampus on a hot, very hot August day. Our son was interested in going to Wentworth and football had topped his interest. As we walked by the field we saw Coach. He broke away from practice & made his way up the hillside. As he neared us his gray shirt was soaked with sweat, his face red, but the two things that defined this man were evident..... a huge, sincere, full of energy and life smile and a Wentworth Dragon emblem worn across the T-shirt. He put his hand out and has never let go of my son. My wife asked him "How do you stand this heat"? His reply, "TLOVE IT!!!"

Now, that all sounds great. We have all heard of people that love football, are great people and love kids. But that is just the surface of this man. He does this for every kid he comes in contact with. He tells them when he loves them and that he will always love them, but he also lets them know when thay are in pain in the ..., well you know. He tells parents to call him anytime, "I don't sleep much", he says. When you call he answers his phone and helps you. Sometimes the parents (I speak for muself especially) can be a bigger pain in the ... well you know, than the kids. But you would never know by the way Coach talks to you. As time goes by you realize how he achieves his victories. Why anytime a person watches Wentworth Football they realize the team doesn't guit and they see this remarkable person leading them into life victories every step of the way. Coach teaches victories in life lessons. He considers helping people victories, and he hates to lose. Losing a chance to help a kid or a family is not an option.

Each family and team menber can probably recount examples of this experience with Coach. Whether it is benching a player for discipline or poor grades, giving the official an ear full when his players are being treated unfairly, or pulling his players around him, down in the game with no chance to win, yet Coach clapping his hands saying these familiar words, "Ok, ok, we're ok now. Come on now, play hard. Lets get this one". Then the unexplainable happens: 11 players, beaten and bruised, come roaring out of the huddle, finish the game and hug each other, congratuate the other team, and walk back to the locker room. The next week, they come back out and play hard again. We drive back home and brag to our family and friends about our Wentworth football team.

Standing beside him all the way is Coach Grosso. If you want to know the truth about something, ask Coach Grosso. He is a man that will not candy coat it for you. He knows exactly what needs to be done to win, yet understands that it isn't a perfect world at Wentworth. You don't have kids that have played together since 5th grade. You also don't have kids that will be able to play on Friday regardless of what their grades or discipline status may be. Now, I say he understands it, but he doesn't like it. It isn't because he wants to win for him, he wants to win for his players. You see, Coach and him share a common bond. They love people, and they see kids as people. Maybe the key at Wentworth starts with the common belief that these two men share. starting with the football player, but echoing throughout the halls of the classrooms they go to as well. They believe that people are good first, make them prove to you that they aren't before you condemn them, then don't condemn them, still believe they are good and help them. This is why kids play for them, learn for them and love them.

If someone were to ask me what my wishes for the future it is simple..... I want to see Doak, Duke, Nick, Anthony, Chad and the rest of the team at an alumni weekend, some of them fitting into their letter jackets nicely, others wearing it a little tight around the middle from the passing years. Some with gray hair and others with no hair. Maybe one of them is a doctor, another a lawyer, maybe one of them getting ready to retire from the military. They are walking the campus, remembering the rules they used to break, the trouble they got into, all the good times they had and friendships they made. Maybe I am around, maybe Coach is too, or maybe we have had our time. I can see these young men, now older with families, who have all made differences in the future. And maybe just one of them looks up to the heavens and says, "Thanks Coach, we won."

Note: Susie is going on with the help of his niece, Ashley, to continue serving Wentworth. For that we are lucky.








